



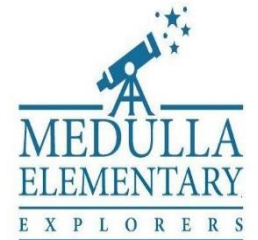

Student/Teacher data chats/conferences will take place in order to set goals and monitor progress.	Review my child's progress reports and work he/she brings home. Talk with my child about their academic goals and the progress they are making. Attend parent/teacher conferences. Visit the parent portal.	Set goals, self-reflect and monitor progress toward goals. Strive to succeed.
Partnership Be Involved	Building relationships with the community, parents, and students through SAC, conferencing, parent workshops, and school events. Utilizing approved volunteers to enhance learning.	Attend family events and parent/teacher conferences at school. Become an approved school volunteer. Visit Parent Resource Centers and Parent University.	Read and do homework every night. Inform parents of school activities and events. Be an enthusiastic learner.
Communication Stay Informed	Using student agendas, email, letters, and the school website to keep parents 'in the know.' Schedule meetings and activities at a variety of times/days, with translation available so that all families can attend and be involved.	Stay connected with my child's teacher by reading, signing and returning the agenda and other documents, daily. Ask school staff if I have any questions, concerns or am in need of any resources.	Talk to teachers and parents about school. Ask them questions. Return homework and agenda daily.
Learning Environment	Meet individual student's needs with appropriate interventions using MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support). Provide a safe, healthy environment and have high expectations for all.	Make sure my child attends school every day, all day, and is on time. Provide my child with a quiet place and time for completing homework and studying. Review my child's homework with him/her and provide assistance, if needed.	Have a positive attitude, participate in class, and ask for help if needed. Be a S.T.A.R. (Safe, Tolerant and respectful, Active learner, Responsible) student.
