

### School's History & Demographics:

Built in 1905, Medulla school has 42 classroom teachers, 5 resource teachers, 16 paraprofessionals and 27 other staff. The enrollment data collected in spring 2015 was 665 students. Of this total enrollment, 21% African-American, 38% white, and 35% Hispanic.



**Title I Information:** Medulla Elementary is a Community Eligibility Provision School, therefore 100% of the students receive free breakfast and lunch. Based on our Title I budget, \$3,081.66 is required to be spent on Parent Involvement.

Parent input is collected as to how these funds will be spent.

These funds are used for student agendas and materials for family involvement events.
