

# Kindergarten Registration Requirements

- Category 1 (REQUIRED)-Apartment rent receipt, mortgage document, property tax record
- Category 2-one CURRENT utility bill (gas, cable, phone, water)
- Category 3- CURRENT voter registration card
- Category 4- PROOF of CURRENT government benefits (Medicare, disability, food stamps, DCF correspondence)

## Immunization Requirements for Kindergarten

The State of Florida, Florida Department of Health, immunization requirements for Kindergarten school entry in 2009-2010 are as follows: **TWO** doses of Varicella (chicken pox) (unless proof of disease) will be required for **ALL** students entering Kindergarten.

In addition, students entering Kindergarten will need:

- five doses of DTaP (Diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis) vaccine,
- four doses of Polio vaccine,
- two doses of MMR (Measles-Mumps-Rubella),
- and three doses of Hep B (Hepatitis B) are required.

A Kindergarten entry physical along with the Florida Certificate of Immunization will be required at time of school registration (Thursday, April 23rd). Please check with your child's doctor or the Health Department for any questions regarding these requirements. Please, make an appointment with your child's doctor or Health Department early on as they get very busy closer to August and appointments become more difficult to find.

## School-Wide Positive Behavior Support (PBS) at SHES

PBS is the application of positive interventions and system changes to achieve socially important behavior change. PBS is also a behaviorally-based systems approach to improving the capability of schools, families, and communities to design effective and positive environments in which teaching and learning occur. PBS requires a collaborative team consisting of administrators, teachers, support personnel, behavior specialist, and, eventually, parents. Sleepy Hill's PBS Team has worked on developing a school-wide plan that includes the following components:

1. Expectations and rules that are clearly and positively defined:

### **Sleepy Hill Elementary Expectations**

**Show Respect**

**Healthy Attitude**

**Explore Responsibly**

**Safety Always**

2. Lesson plans for teaching the expectations and rules to staff and then to students.

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3. The acknowledgement of appropriate behaviors through positive praise, a school-wide reward system, and class-wide reward systems. For the school-wide system, students are rewarded charms/tokens (that go on chains) for outstanding behavior that reflects the school's expectations and classroom or area rules. Students who earn enough tokens by the end of each month use these tokens to attend a reward event at the end of the month.
4. The proactive correction of behavioral errors through corrective feedback and discipline.
5. The use of discipline data for monitoring PBS progress and making decisions regarding changes to the PBS process monthly.
