Use higher order thinking questions, collaborative pairs, and RADS for written responses throughout the content areas.	Establish a routine so that your child is on time for school, prepared, and dressed according to our code of conduct and school dress code. Bring only the required materials to school.	Understand that actions have consequences. Accept responsibility for my actions. Be respectful of the learning environment so that everyone can learn. Consider cultural differences.
